**National Institute of Development Administration
Master of Management Program, English Program
Application for Tuition Fee Partial Scholarship
1st Semester, Academic Year 2017**

The National Institute of Development Administration (NIDA) aims to encourage and support individuals with outstanding academic performance at Bachelor's Degree level to pursue their Master's Degree education (Regular Program). NIDA is granting scholarships. The scholarships granted are classified into 3 types:

1. Scholarship Type 1 Scholarship recipients shall be waived from tuition fees throughout the program of study. Monthly allowances and other educational support will also be provided throughout the program.
2. Scholarship Type 2 Scholarship recipients shall be waived from tuition fees throughout the program of study.
3. Scholarship Type 3 Scholarship recipients shall pay half of tuition fees throughout the program of study.

The Graduate School of Tourism Management, National Institute of Development Administration (NIDA) invites applications for admission to Master of Management program in Integrated Tourism and Hospitality Management (English Program) for 1st Semester, the 2017 Academic Year. Five majors are available:

- Integrated Tourism and Hospitality, Policy, Planning and Management.
- Integrated Tourism and Hospitality Management.
- Hotel Management.
- Airline and Transportation Management.
- Hospitality Management.

1. Applicant Qualifications

1.1 Students who enter into the program shall meet the following requirements in English proficiency, specified by NIDA:

- a. 500 points in TOEFL or higher,
- b. 5.5 points in IELTS or higher,
- c. Results of an English test by the Chinese government at level 6 or higher,
- d. Results of an English test by NIDA (NIDA TEAP) at level 500 or higher

1.2 Qualification of Applicants Scholarship Type 1 and 2 must hold a Bachelor's Degree or the equivalent, or be currently studying in the last semester of a Bachelor's Degree program (Applicants must graduate before the beginning of the semester in which the program at NIDA starts). Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.75 in their Bachelor's Degree

1.3 Qualification of Applicants Scholarship Type 3 must hold a Bachelor's Degree or the equivalent, or be currently studying in the last semester of a Bachelor's Degree program (Applicants must graduate before the beginning of the semester in which the program at NIDA starts). Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.50 in their Bachelor's Degree

NIDA reserves the right to examine documents and eligibility of an applicant at any time. If the applicant is found ineligible after being admitted the announcement of acceptance shall be considered null and void.

The periods of validity of the test score are as follows:

- 1) NIDA TEAP score is valid for 1 year until the date of submission
- 2) TOEFL and IELTS are valid for 2 years until the date of submission Enrollment to English for graduate studies courses and the exemption from the courses are determined in compliance with the criteria and requirements stipulated in the English for graduate studies program by the Graduate School of Language and Communication, National Institute of Development Administration.
- 3) Duration, All courses take on 4 – 5 semesters and 1 – 2 summer sessions, depending on the area of study/major. All subjects/majors have to register 9 credits each semester except the summer session.
- 4) Tuition fees may change as appropriate according to an announcement by NIDA.

3. Application Procedure and Payment of Fees

Applications, accompanied by an application fee of 200 baht, must be submitted to the Educational Service Division at the Financial Division, 3rd Floor, Prince Naradhip Bongsprabansha Building. (Open weekdays 8.30 a.m. – 4.30 p.m. except holidays).

Note: The documents mentioned in 4.6.1 and 4.6.2, above, must be submitted before the start of the term, Applicants who fail to submit all required documents will not be admitted to the program.

The Institute reserves the right to verify the applicants' qualifications at any time, Applicants who do not have required qualifications will not be admitted to the program. No refunds will be issued. If, An applicant has already been accepted but is subsequently determined to be unqualified, scholarship awards will be canceled.

5. Selection Procedures

The program committee will decide which applicants are to be interviewed by the faculty members of the Graduate School of Tourism Management. The committee will evaluate applicants based on credentials, education, and experience.

6. Conditions for Partial Scholarship

Students who have been accepted into the program under the tuition fee and English course fee exemption project will be exempt from tuition and English course fees under the following conditions:

6.1 Eligibility for Scholarship

Good Learning Scholarship

6.1.1 Recipients of the Scholarship Type 1,2 must have:A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 for the Bachelor's Degree

6.1.2 Recipients of the Scholarship Type 3 must have:A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 for the Bachelor's Degree

6.2 Scholarship recipients must achieve a GPA of at least 3.30 in each semester; otherwise, the tuition fee exemption will be canceled.

6.3 Scholarship the recipients If the recipients go on a leave of absence, they will lose the right to tuition fee exemption. If decides to drop the program, they must pay back all tuition fees, they were exempted from to the date of withdrawal.

6.4 Scholarship recipients must graduate within the program duration and at every end of the semester, applicants have to report the academic result to the program committee.

6.5 Scholarship recipients must enroll to repeat the course or the course program is not set, applicants will not be exempt from tuition and English course fees for that course,

6.6 Scholarship recipients must contribute their time to join the school/ the institute's activities.

6.7 Scholarship recipients shall work for graduate School or the Institute at least 6 hours per week

6.8 Scholarship recipients who are international students shall abide by the institute health insurance policy, it not, they forfeit their scholarship.
