Application for Scholarship type 2 for the Academic Year 1/2018

The National Institute of Development Administration (NIDA) is accepting applications for admission to the Master of Public Administration Program (English Program) MPA-Public Policy and Strategic Management for the academic year 1/2018.

1. Qualification of Applicants

1.1. Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree or are studying in last semester (and to graduate before first intake start), minimum GPA 2.75 in any field from a university or institution accredited by the Commission on Higher Education.

1.2. Applicants who graduated from abroad must provide a letter of accreditation for received degrees that is issued by Commission on Higher Education.

2. Application Forms

2.1 Applications forms can be obtained by contacting the Educational Service Division, 3rd Floor, Prince Naradhip Bongsprabandha Building between 8.30 – 16.30 hrs. 2.2.1 Download the application form and print out on A4 paper only, do not change the format of the form, otherwise, it will not be accepted for the application process.

3. Application procedure and Payment of Fees

Applications accompanied by an application fee of 200 baht, must be submitted to the Educational Service Division, 3rd Floor, Prince Naradhip Bongsprabandha Building between 8.30 – 16.30 hrs. (Except government holidays)

4.3 Complete official transcript(s) of undergraduate studies (1 copy)

4.4 Copy of personal identity card (if applicable)

4.5 Copy of passport (Non-Thai applicants)

4.6 Evidence of any change of name (if applicable)

4.7 One 1-inch photo taken no more than six months prior to application date

4.8 For applicants who graduate from an institute outside Thailand:

4.8.1 A Letter of Confirmation on Standard Curriculum for the Bachelor's Degree. This can be obtained from the Bureau of Standards and Evaluation at the Commission on Higher Education, Ministry of Education.

4.8.2 An Official Letter of Certification for their Bachelor's Degree with their University Council's approval as well as a complete transcript with the specified date of graduation which must be sent directly from the applicant's university to the address below:

4.9 Applicants are required to submit a test score of either 500 for TOEFL, 5.5 IELTS, 500 NIDA TEAP or the Test of English Proficiency that conducted by standard organization or representative of the government from applicants' country (Applicant might get the permission to not provide evidence of English Proficiency or might require to attend English Foundation in case of failure from this English criteria, considered by course committee and shall approve by the Dean.

Note: 1) The documents mentioned in 4.8.1 and 4.8.2 above, must be submitted before the start of the term. Applicants who fail to submit all required documents will not be admitted to the program.

2) Evidence of English Literature must be submitted before first semester ends.

The institute reserves the right to verify the applicants' qualifications at any time. Applications who do not have the required qualifications will not be admitted to the program. No refunds will be issued. If an applicant has already been accepted but is subsequently determined to be unqualified, scholarship awards will be canceled.

5. Terms and Conditions for Scholarship Recipients

5.1 Eligibility for Scholarship

5.1.1 Good Learning Scholarship

1) Recipients of the Scholarship Type 2 must have:

- A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 for the Bachelor's Degree

5.2 Amount of Good Learning Scholarship and International Relations Scholarship

5.2.1 Recipients of the Scholarship Type 2 shall be completely exempt from the entire tuition fee throughout the program

5.3 Scholarship Requirements

5.3.1 Good Learning Scholarship

Recipients of the Scholarship Type 2 shall maintain a minimum GPA of 3.30 in each semester. If the GPA fails to meet the criterion for any semester, the scholarship shall be immediately discontinued.

5.3.2 The recipient's leave of absence for any semester shall result in immediate cancellation of the scholarship. If resigning from the Institute or cancelling the scholarship, the recipient shall reimburse the award scholarship in full to the Institute, unless the Committee considers otherwise;

5.3.3 In the event that scholarship recipients have to repeat any course, they shall not be exempt from the tuition fee for such re-enrolled class;

5.3.4 In the event that scholarship recipients wish to enroll in any course beyond their study plan, they shall be exempt from the tuition fee of such class upon recommendations in respect of the advisor only;

5.3.5 Scholarship recipients shall be exempt from the fee for the first-time comprehensive examination only. Consecutive comprehensive examinations shall not be exempt;

5.3.6 When the scholarship period ends, the student status retention fee shall be paid by scholarship recipients themselves;

5.3.7 Scholarship recipients shall work for the graduate school or the Institute at least 6 hours a week;

5.3.8 The recipient has no rights to apply for any other scholarships of the Institute, except for the financial aids for research conduct and publication allocated from the state budget.

5.4 Scholarship recipients who are International students shall abide by the health Insurance policy stipulated by the Institute. If not, they forfeit their scholarship.

5.5 Standard Duration of Scholarship (Counting from the first day when the scholarship recipient is registered as a student)

The award period shall be 2 years.
