#### **1. Documents for Registration**

- 1.1 Bachelor's degree (2 copies).

Graduates from institutes outside Thailand must provide:

A Letter of Confirmation on Standard Curriculum of the degrees from the Commission on Higher Education, Ministry of Education.

- 1.2 Official transcripts (2 copies for Bachelor Degree).
- 1.3 House registration certificate (2 copies).
- 1.4 National ID Card (2 copies)

1.5 Medical certificate issued by a doctor (A medical certificate issued by a physician or a medically qualified healthcare provider which certifies that you are free of contagious diseases or other serious health conditions that can interfere with your study. This medical certificate can be requested at any private or public hospitals and clinics and must be valid within one month only.)

1.6 Three photographs (1” Size, not wearing academic gown)

1.7 Evidence of any change of name, e.g., Marriage Certificate (2 copies)

1.8 Passport / VISA (international student only)

1.9 Request form for Student ID Card (The form can be downloaded from

<http://edserv.nida.ac.th/th/student/freshman>. Fill in the form with handwriting)

N.B. (i) All photocopies of documents must be signed by the applicant (certified copy).

(ii) Students cannot register in more than one program at NIDA. If they are current students in any program at NIDA, their registration in the new program shall be cancelled.

NIDA reserves the right to examine documents and qualifications of an applicant at any time. If it is found that an applicant does not meet the required qualifications, the announcement of acceptance of that person shall be cancelled.

**18<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup> March 2021:** Online registration authentication by filling the form in <https://forms.gle/6hDetN97fSMgwZV1A>. After the authentication is complete, the instruction for new students registration will be sent to the email registered in the authentication process. **25<sup>th</sup> – 31<sup>st</sup> March 2021:** Students login to <http://reg.nida.ac.th/> to complete personal data and enroll in coursework. If fail to complete personal data by the specified time, students will be dropped from registration.

**25<sup>th</sup> March – 1<sup>st</sup> April 2021:** Students pay the registration fee at Bangkok Bank or Kasikorn Bank or Krungsri Bank or Counter Service (Online payment is also valid). If fail to make the payment by the specified time, students will be dropped from registration.

### 4. First day of classes

Classes will begin on 9<sup>th</sup> August 2021. Applicants who are on leave for study must provide a letter that confirms their leave from his/her employer by 9<sup>th</sup> August 2021, otherwise the registration shall be incomplete.
