on Application for Admission to Master of Science Program in Logistics Management
(Double Degree English Program)
Semester 2 Academic Year 2019

The National Institute of Development Administration (NIDA) will accept applications for admission to the Master of Science Program in Logistics Management (Double Degree English Program) for the semester 2 academic year 2019 as follows:

1. Qualifications of the Applicants

1.1 Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree in field or related fields from a university or institution accredited by the Commission on Higher Education.

1.2 Applicants who graduated from abroad must provide a letter of accreditation for the received degrees that is issued by Commission on Higher Education. For Thai applicants, the letter must be submitted prior to interview examination.

Remark Applicants can be qualified to apply for Scholarship Type 1, 2 or 3 on following conditions of GPA in Bachelor Degree;

Scholarship Type 1 (Full scholarship with monthly stipend): GPA 2.75 or above

Scholarship Type 2 (Tuition fee exemption): GPA 2.75 or above

Scholarship Type 3 (Half tuition fee exemption): GPA 2.50 or above

2. Selection Procedure

Applicants must conform to NIDA's announcement on English proficiency requirements as follows:

2.1 Unless applicants are native English speakers or have obtained their bachelor's not more than five years from international academic institutions where English was the language of instruction and study, they must submit a test score of International English Language Testing System (IELTS) of 5.0 on the date of application

2.2 Interview

The committee will be chosen from the faculty members of the Graduate School of Applied Statistics. The committee will evaluate applicants based on credentials, education and experiences.

3. Application Procedure

3.2 Applying in Person: Application can be made in person at Educational Service Division from now to 9th August 2019 (8.30 – 16.30 hrs except government holidays) for the first application and from 10th August to 11th October 2019 for the second application. Application fee is 200 baht.

4.6 Official test scores (IELTS)

NIDA reserves the rights to examine all documents and qualifications of an applicant at any time. If it is found that an applicant does not meet the required qualifications after an acceptance has already been given, the announcement of acceptance shall be cancelled.


5. Application Schedule

5.1 Application for Admission to Master of Science Program in Logistics Management (English Program), will be made twice a year during December to February and February to April for the semester 1 of academic year 2019 as follows:

First application for semester 2 (January 2020– May 2020)	
- Last day to apply to study (online)	28 th July 2019
- Last day to apply to study (in person)	9 th August 2019
- Announcement of the interview examination	19 th August 2019
- Interview examination	26 th August 2019
- Final results	16 th September 2019

Second application for semester 2 (January 2020– May 2020)	
- Last day to apply to study (online)	29 th September 2019
- Last day to apply to study (in person)	11 th October 2019
- Announcement of the interview examination	18 th October 2019
- Interview examination	28 th October 2019
- Final results	18 th November 2019
