### National Institute of Development Administration on Application for Admission to Master of Science Program in Logistics Management (English Program) Semester 1 Academic Year 2022

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The National Institute of Development Administration (NIDA) will accept applications for admission to the Master of Science Program in Logistics Management (English Program) for the semester 1 academic year 2022 as follows:

#### 1. Qualifications of the Applicants

- 1.1 Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree in field or related fields from a university or institution accredited by the Commission on Higher Education.
- 1.2 Applicants who graduated from abroad must provide a letter of accreditation for the received degrees that is issued by Commission on Higher Education. For Thai applicants, the letter must be submitted prior to interview examination.

**Remark** Applicants can be qualified to apply for Scholarship Type 1, 2 or 3 on following conditions of GPA in Bachelor Degree;

Scholarship Type 1 (Full scholarship with monthly stipend): GPA 3.00 or above

Scholarship Type 2 (Tuition fee exemption): GPA 2.75 or above

Scholarship Type 3 (Half tuition fee exemption): GPA 2.50 or above

## 2. Selection Procedure

Applicants must conform to NIDA's announcement on English proficiency requirements as follows:

2.1 Unless applicants are native English speakers or have obtained their bachelor's not more than five years from international academic institutions where English was the language of instruction and study, they must submit a test score of either the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) or NIDA Test of English for Academic Purposes (NIDA TEAP). The minimum score for TOEFL (Paper-based), TOEFL (CBT), TOEFL (IBT), IELTS and NIDA TEAP is as follows;

2.1.1 TOEFL (Paper-based) : 500 or above

2.1.2 TOEFL (CBT) : 173 or above

2.1.3 TOEFL (IBT) : 61 or above

2.1.4 IELTS : 5.5 or above

2.1.5 NIDA TEAP : 500 or above

2.2 Interview

The committee will be chosen from the faculty members of the Graduate School of Applied Statistics. The committee will evaluate applicants based on credentials, education and experiences.

## 4. Application Procedure

Apply online by following these steps:

- 4.1 Go to the Institute's website at <https://entrance.nida.ac.th>
- 4.2 Log in to the system. For new users, register to get into the online application system.
- 4.3 Choose a school and a program of study for application form.
- 4.4 Fill out applicant's profile information.
- 4.5 Save the application information, verify the information and confirm the application.

- 4.6 Print out an invoice of application fee. Make the payment of application fee, via the following options:
- Pay at any branches of Bangkok Bank Public Company Limited;
  - Pay at any Counter Service Centers (7-eleven stores); or
  - Pay via mobile or online banking.
- 4.7 Upload the required documents onto the Attached Files System or send the documents by e-mail to [applynida-t@nida.ac.th](mailto:applynida-t@nida.ac.th)

**Notes:**

- 1) The paid application fee is non-refundable.
- 2) The submitted documents will not be returned.
- 3) If applicants are unable to complete the documentation and payment process, the application will be considered invalid and the applicants will not be eligible for any examinations for admission.
- 4) The examination application is complete when the Institute verifies the application documents and payment made within the prescribed time.
- 5) Applicants can check their application status two days after the payment has been made at <https://entrance.nida.ac.th>

**5. Required Documents**

- 5.1 Application Form (can be downloaded from <https://entrance.nida.ac.th>)
- 5.2 Official transcripts of all university studies
- 5.3 Degree Certificate
- 5.4 Thai National ID Card or Passport (for foreigner)
- 5.5 Digital photos taken not more than six months prior to the application date.
- 5.6 Official test scores (TOEFL or IELTS or NIDA TEAP)

**Note:** Applicants must submit all required documents before the interview date; otherwise, the application will be considered incomplete and will be voided. The student status will be automatically terminated, or subject to NIDA council's discretion.

NIDA reserves the rights to examine all documents and qualifications of an applicant at any time. If it is found that an applicant does not meet the

required qualifications after an acceptance has already been given, the announcement of acceptance shall be cancelled.

For applicants who graduated from institutions outside Thailand, the following documents are required:

- 5.7 A Letter of Confirmation on Standard Curriculum for the Bachelor's Degree, which can be obtained by submitting a request along with a copy of a complete transcript directly to the Bureau of Standards and Evaluation at the Commission on Higher Education in Bangkok, Thailand (Contact the Educational Service Division for more information)
- 5.8 An Official Letter of Certification for their Bachelor's Degree with their University Council's approval as well as a complete transcript with the specified date of graduation. This can be sent directly to an email address: [applynida-t@nida.ac.th](mailto:applynida-t@nida.ac.th). Please specify in the email subject "Application for Admission to Master of Science Program in Logistics Management (English Program)."

**Note:** Applicants graduated from an institute outside Thailand must submit these documents before the class start; otherwise, the application will be considered incomplete and will be voided. The student status will be automatically terminated, or subject to NIDA council's discretion. NIDA reserves the right to examine documents and eligibility of an applicant at any time. If applicants are later found ineligible for admission after the acceptance has been given, the announcement of acceptance shall be considered null & void.

## 6. Application Schedule

Application for Admission to Master of Science Program in Logistics Management (English Program), will be made twice a year during January to February and February to May for the semester 1 of academic year 2022 as follows:

Application for semester 1 (August - December 2022)	
- Last day to apply (online)	20 <sup>th</sup> June 2022
- Announcement of the interview examination	22 <sup>nd</sup> June 2022
- Interview examination	24 <sup>th</sup> June 2022
- Final results	6 <sup>th</sup> July 2022
